Drug Abuse Prevention Day program under the auspices

Dravidian University NSS. An awareness program was organized for students on the occasion of International Drug Abuse Prevention Day at the Emeno Guest House on 26-06-2025. On this occasion, Dravidian University Vice Chancellor Prof. M. Doraswamy said that human life is very valuable, we have the opportunity to shape our life well, and we should utilize our time well and thus shine at a higher level. Therefore, he advised students to be vigilant and stay away from drugs even during their student days and not become addicted to them. He stated that if a student is busy with other activities instead of studying when they should be studying, they will end up with difficulties.

Dean Academic Affairs Dr. Shyamala said that drug use can damage health, and that youth should live responsibly, keeping in mind the hopes of their parents, and that prevention of drug abuse should be achieved at the individual, family, and community levels.

Excise Circle Inspector Shri A. Nagaraju said that the use of phones is being misused, which is causing many harms, and that those who take drugs will be punished no matter how great they are.
